

HUMAN HAIR AFTERCARE ADVICE

Step-by-step guide to washing your wig/hairpiece

1. Prior to washing, remove all knots and tangles paying particular attention to the nape section.
2. Fill a hand bowl or sink with tepid water and apply a little **Pureology Shampoo**. Repeat twice if needed. Rinse well. Always apply products from root to tip.
3. Gently smooth through some **Pureology Condition**.
At the stage you can apply the **Pureology Mask**
4. Thoroughly rinse the conditioner out.
5. Pat gently with a towel to remove excess water. Never rub. Spritz some **Pureology Colour Fanatic** on the hair.
6. Place on a Polyhead/Workhead to dry naturally.
7. Style with heat as desired. You can do this when wet or completely dry.
8. To finish, apply your **Redken** finishing/styling products.

Before / after wearing, gently remove any knots and tangles with the fingers or soft brush.

If worn daily wash at least every 7-10 days.

Important notes

Any type of heated appliance can be used on human hair for the desired style/look.

With our lighter shades of blonde we recommend you do not exceed 180° on the temperature gauge.

All finishing products from our **Redken** range are recommended, from hairspray to wax and serum.

All human hair wigs will fade. This is due to an oxidization process that happens in the environment.

This will occur within the first few months of wear. The colour can be restored.
Human hair can be dyed darker but not lighter.

Should you like to re-colour your human hair, please seek professional advice.

Please use a gentle wig brush and not a comb. Be careful when brushing the wig when wet.

Longer human hair will need brushing more often. This will reduce the knots and tangles that happen naturally at the nape of the neck. We recommend brushing your long hair numerous times a day.

Most human hair wigs will have tape tabs. Please use the tape if desired on the P.U areas for extra security. Please note, we do not recommend taping if you have hair on those areas of the scalp.

For flexible partings select a wig that has a hand knotted monofilament top finish.

The 2 rules for putting on your wig correctly are to position the wig line at the front 4 fingers width from your brow bone and to ensure the tabs on each side of the wig are evenly positioned so the wig is straight.

If you have some hair underneath a wig, for extra security you can attach either Snap Lok Combs or Kirby Grips to the wig then onto your existing hair.

We do not recommend you sleep in your wig/hairpiece, it will cut the lifespan by at least half.
